As well as learning from expert speakers in a range of fields, you will have the opportunity to build relationships with other emerging leaders from across the spheres of politics, the arts, media, academia, business, education, civil society, and more.

WHAT?

- 4 weekend equipping events

WHEN?

Retreat dates: 31 January - 2 February, 26 - 27 April, 12 - 13 July, 11 - 12 October

Discovery events: One between each retreat, dates TBC

Mentoring: One session after every retreat, plus one additional at the end of the year.

WHO?

- 20s and 30s age range
- Passion for Christ
- Sense of call to leadership
- Evidence of activating that calling
- Recognised by their church
- Humble and teachable character

WHAT WILL THE CURRICULUM INVOLVE?

We draw together a bespoke curriculum for the course based on good practice from the UK and beyond. Content includes Christian character, cultural intelligence, calling and competency.

WHAT ABOUT THE MENTORING?

All participants will be paired with an experienced mentor. These are experienced leaders who will walk the journey with you throughout the year ensuring that you are able to put into practice what God is teaching you.

HOW MUCH DOES IT COST?

Most of the costs are covered by the Evangelical Alliance but we ask for a contribution from participants of around £795. Bursaries may be available in cases of financial need.
